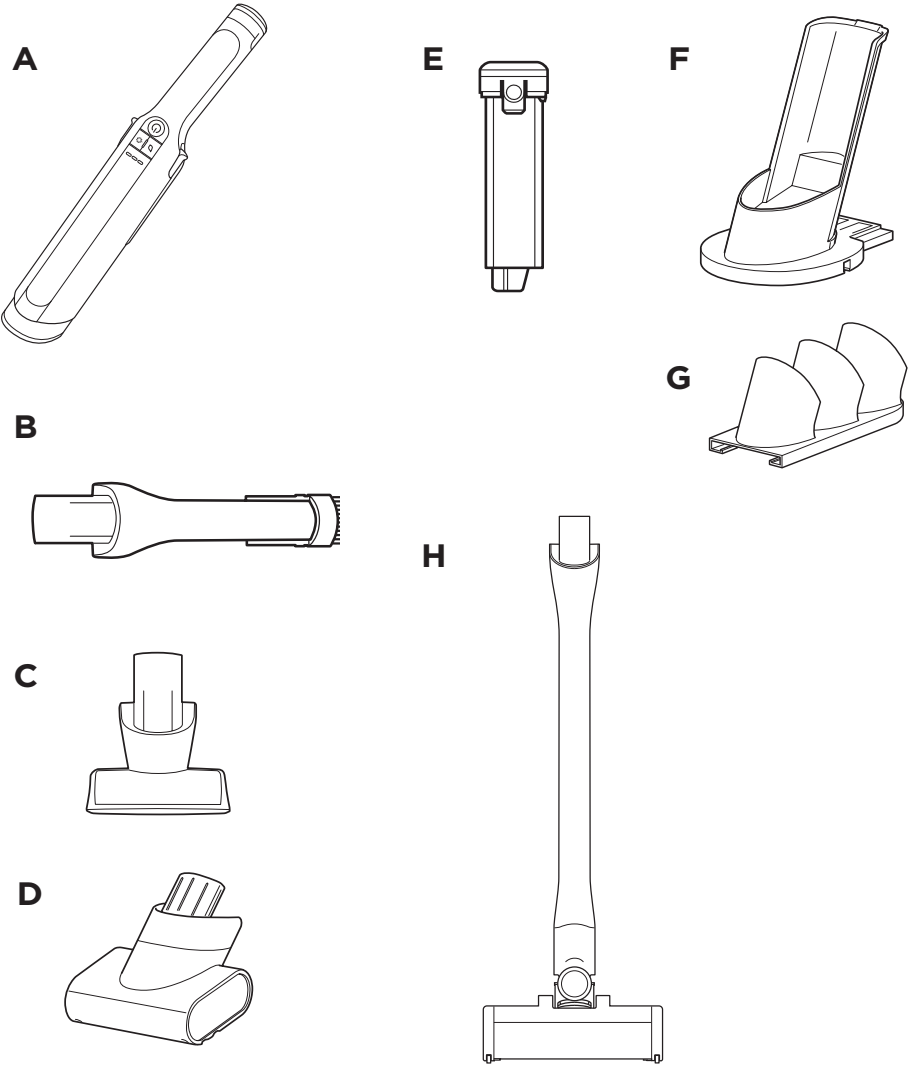

SAFETY WARNINGS

This product is intended for home use. Do not use the vacuum cleaner for commercial purposes or for purposes other than cleaning.

The following are guidelines to prevent injury and property damage to the user or others.

If the power plug cannot be inserted into the outlet, turn it the other way and reinsert. Contact customer support if the plug does cannot be inserted properly into the outlet even when turned the other way. Do not force the plug into the outlet or alter the plug to make it fit.

 **WARNING** (Death or serious injury can result if the vacuum cleaner is used incorrectly.) Follow the instructions below to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury, or physical damage.

 **WARNING** Do not use the vacuum cleaner to vacuum up water or other liquids.

WARNINGS ABOUT POWER SUPPLIES, INCLUDING ELECTRIC WIRES, CHARGERS, AND VACUUM CLEANERS

1. This product does not contain parts that can be repaired by customers.
2. Do not vacuum up liquids.
3. Do not remove the filter or dust cup or expose the parts of the vacuum cleaner to water or other liquids.
4. Stop using the vacuum cleaner if it becomes damaged.
5. To avoid fire, explosion, or injury, prior to using the vacuum cleaner, inspect the vacuum cleaner and charger and ensure that they are not damaged. Stop using the vacuum cleaner if any parts are damaged.
6. Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces. Only use the vacuum cleaner on dry surfaces.
7. Do not use the vacuum cleaner if it does not work normally, or if it is dropped, damaged, left outside, or submerged in water.
8. Do not handle the vacuum cleaner or the power supply plug with wet hands.
9. Do not leave the vacuum cleaner with the power on.
10. Do not place the vacuum cleaner in places where its surface could heat up.
11. Make sure to turn off the power to the vacuum cleaner before connecting it to the charger.
12. To charge the vacuum cleaner, use the included charging dock with charging adapter (XDCKWV500TW) or the genuine Shark® battery charger (WV500TWTP), sold separately. Do not use batteries other than XSBT330AS. There is a risk of fire if other parts are used. Charge the vacuum cleaner in a flat, stable area.

13. Do not dispose of the vacuum cleaner by burning it even if it is severely damaged. The lithium-ion battery may explode in fire.

GENERAL USE

14. Do not carry the charger by its cord. When removing the vacuum cleaner from the outlet, always do so by holding the power supply plug itself. Do not remove from the outlet by pulling on the cord.
15. Do not let the charger cord come into contact with warm surfaces.
16. Be sure to use the vacuum cleaner as described in the manual. Do not use the vacuum cleaner for any purpose other than those explained in this user manual.
17. Use the vacuum cleaner in well-lit locations.
18. To prevent malfunction when attaching and removing the charger, dust cup, filter, and other accessories, be sure to turn off the power to the vacuum cleaner.
19. Do not place foreign objects inside the suction port or openings.
20. Do not use the vacuum cleaner if its opening is blocked. Remove any objects that may obstruct the flow of air, such as dirt, lint, or hair.
21. Individuals with physical, sensory, or cognitive disabilities, or those who lack sufficient experience or knowledge (such as children) should not use this product except under the supervision or guidance of someone who is responsible for their safety.
 - a) Children should not play with the vacuum cleaner.
 - b) Children should not clean or perform maintenance on the vacuum cleaner except under the supervision of a guardian.

22. Do not use the vacuum cleaner if the dust cup and filter are not properly attached.
23. Do not use the vacuum cleaner if the suction pathway is blocked. If there is a foreign object inside, turn off the power to the vacuum cleaner, remove all foreign objects, and turn the power back on.
24. While the vacuum cleaner is running, do not put your hair, face, fingers, feet, or any loose clothing near any of its openings.
25. Use only genuine Shark® accessories.
26. Do not charge the battery at temperatures under 10° C (50° F) or over 40° C (104° F). Charging inappropriately or in environments where the temperature is higher or lower than the specified range may damage the battery, increasing the risk of fire.
27. Store the vacuum cleaner and accessories indoors where the temperature will not fall below 3° C (37.4° F). When using, make sure that vacuum cleaner is at room temperature.

DUST CAP, FILTER, AND ACCESSORIES

Check the following before turning the vacuum cleaner on.

28. After performing maintenance on the filter, make sure to fully dry it before reinstalling it in the vacuum cleaner to ensure that water does not get inside the electrical components.
29. After performing regular maintenance on the dust cup and filter, make sure that they are properly installed.
30. Please ensure that the accessories are not clogged and do not allow your hair, face, or body to come into contact with the openings.
31. Do not use any filters or accessories except genuine Shark® products. The warranty will be voided if non-genuine parts are used.

GENERAL CLEANING

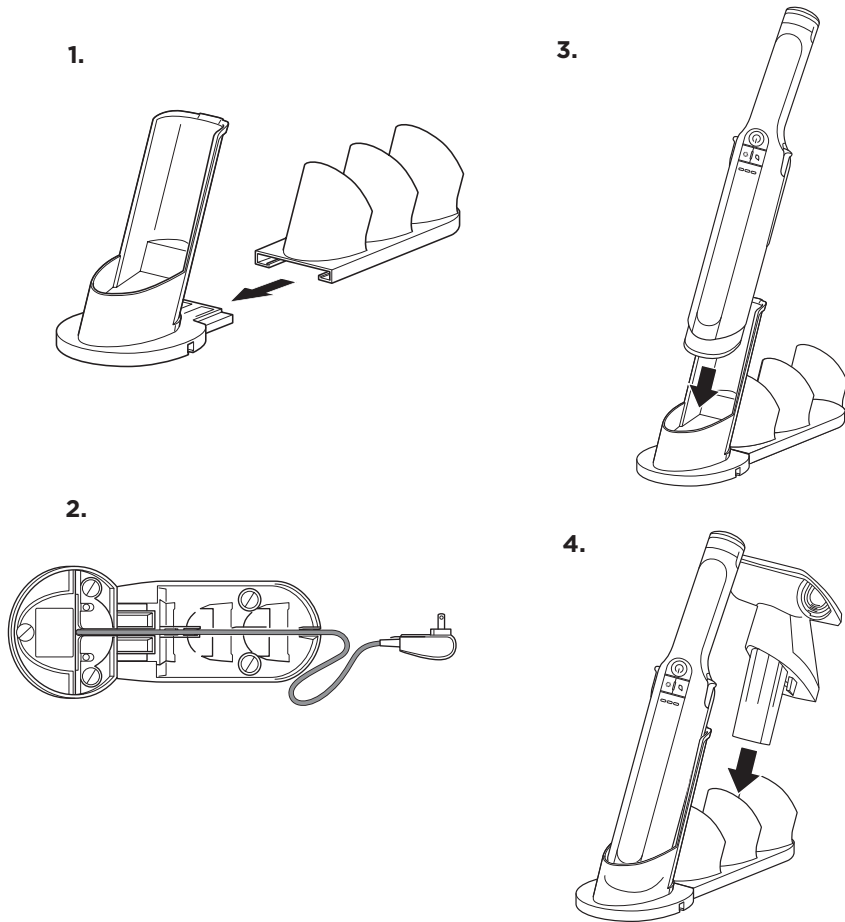
32. Do not vacuum up the following items.
 - a) Liquids
 - b) Large objects
 - c) Hard objects and sharp objects (glass, nails, screws, coins, rocks, etc.)
 - d) Large quantities of dust (drywall dust, fireplace ashes, cinders, flour, etc.). Do not use the vacuum cleaner as an attachment to an electric dust collection tool.
 - e) Objects that are smoking or on fire (hot coals, cigarette butts, matches, etc.)

- f) Flammable or combustible items (diesel oil, gasoline, kerosene, etc.)
 - g) Toxic substances (chlorine bleach, ammonia, drainpipe cleaner, etc.)
33. Do not submerge the vacuum clear in water or other liquids.
 34. Watch your step when cleaning stairs.

BATTERY USAGE

35. The battery is the vacuum cleaner's power source. To prevent malfunction, when carrying the vacuum cleaner, make sure the power is off and that your fingers are not touching the power button. Do not charge the vacuum cleaner when the power is on.
36. Please always use the charger packaged with the vacuum cleaner to charge it. If a non-genuine charger is used, there is a risk of fire.
37. When using the vacuum cleaner, use only the lithium-ion battery packaged with the product. Use of another battery could result in injury or fire.
38. Mishandling the battery could cause electrolytic solution to leak out. This liquid could cause inflammation or burns, so do not touch this liquid. If the liquid sticks to your skin or clothing or gets into your eyes, seek immediate medical attention after washing it off with water.
39. Store the vacuum cleaner indoors. To preserve the life of the battery, do not store the vacuum cleaner in locations where the temperature is less than 3° C (37.4° F) or more than 40° C (104° F).
40. Do not expose the vacuum cleaner or battery to flame or temperatures above 130° C (266° F), as explosion could result.
41. This product does not contain parts that can be repaired by customers. Do not modify or repair the vacuum cleaner or the battery. Do not use the vacuum cleaner if it has been modified or damaged.

ASSEMBLY OF THE CHARGING DOCK



1. Insert the accessory stand from the back of the charging dock, slide, then push it until you hear a click.
2. Feed the charging adapter cord through the groove in the bottom of the charging dock and the accessory stand and pull cord through the notch to the rear.
3. Slide the vacuum cleaner into the opening in the base of the charging dock and stand it up.
4. Insert accessories into the opening on top of the accessory stand.
*The active floor nozzle and wand (included with WV517TW) cannot be stored in the accessory stand.

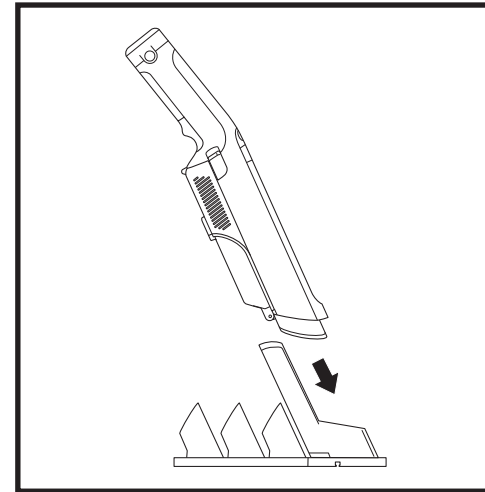
To use the vacuum cleaner appropriately, make sure that all parts are securely connected and fitted in the proper locations.

NOTE: To ensure the stability of the charging dock, make sure to attach the accessory stand to the charging dock when using.

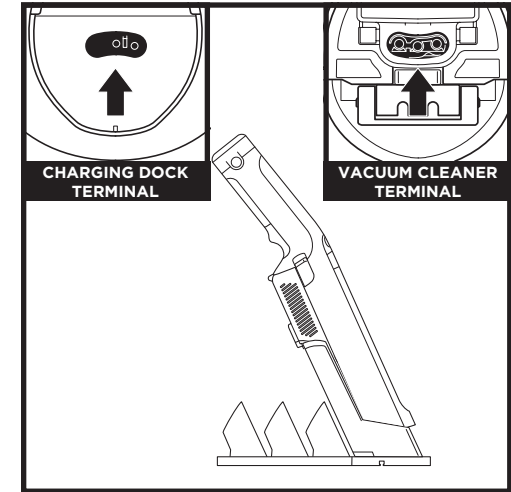
NOTE: In order for the vacuum cleaner to rest securely in the charging slot of the charging dock, make sure to insert accessories into their specified slots. See "Using for the first time" for information about storage positions.

CHARGING

CHARGING IN THE CHARGING DOCK



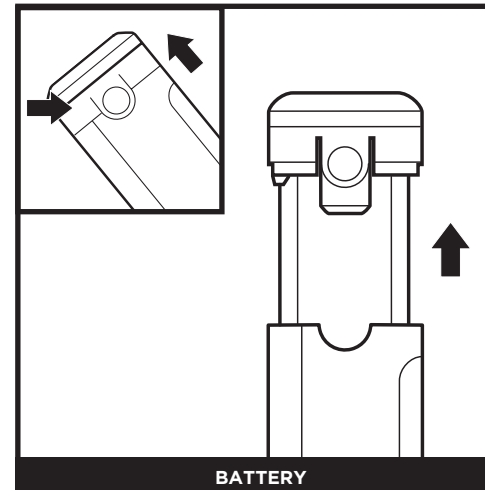
Insert the charging adapter into a wall outlet, etc.
Insert the nozzle end of the vacuum cleaner into the charging dock by sliding it in. Charging will begin automatically.



Make sure that the charging terminal of the vacuum cleaner nozzle is firmly in contact with the charging terminal of the charging dock.

Remove the vacuum cleaner from the charging dock to begin using the vacuum cleaner once charging is complete.

INSERTING AND REMOVING THE BATTERY



To remove the battery from the vacuum cleaner, pull the battery out while pressing the tab on the cap of the battery. To reinstall it, insert the battery into its original location by sliding it and push until you hear a click.

NOTE: When the vacuum cleaner is inserted into the charging dock, the indicator lights on the vacuum cleaner will flash, indicating that charging has begun. When charging is complete, the three lights will all light, then turn off approximately five minutes later.

NOTE: At time of purchase, batteries are shipped in approximately half-charged condition. To maximize the possible operation time, before first using the vacuum cleaner, please fully charge the battery (this takes approximately 3.5 hours). After beginning to use the vacuum cleaner, the battery life will not be harmed even if the vacuum cleaner is left constantly charging.

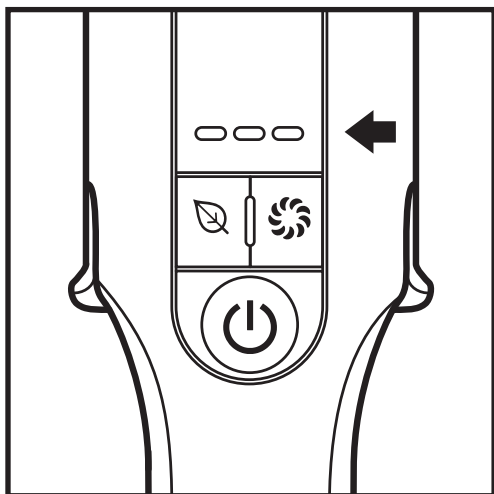
ABOUT THE LITHIUM-ION BATTERY

Fully charge the battery before first using the vacuum cleaner. It will take approximately 3.5 hours to fully charge the battery for the first time.

CONTINUOUS OPERATION TIME WHEN THE BATTERY IS FULLY CHARGED

The maximum continuous operation time with one fully charged battery is 40 minutes.

CHARGING STATUS AND REMAINING BATTERY LIFE ACCORDING TO INDICATOR LIGHT DISPLAY



In use

- Three solid black rectangles: Fully charged
- Two solid black rectangles and one empty rectangle: Approximately half of battery life remaining
- One solid black rectangle and two empty rectangles: Battery nearly fully discharged
- Three rectangles with radiating lines (indicating they are off): Charging cut off or no battery life remaining

When charging

- Three rectangles with radiating lines: No battery life
- Two rectangles with radiating lines and one empty rectangle: Half battery life
- One rectangle with radiating lines and two empty rectangles: Close to fully charged
- Three solid black rectangles: Fully charged

NOTE: The indicator lights will turn off approximately five minutes after the battery is fully charged.

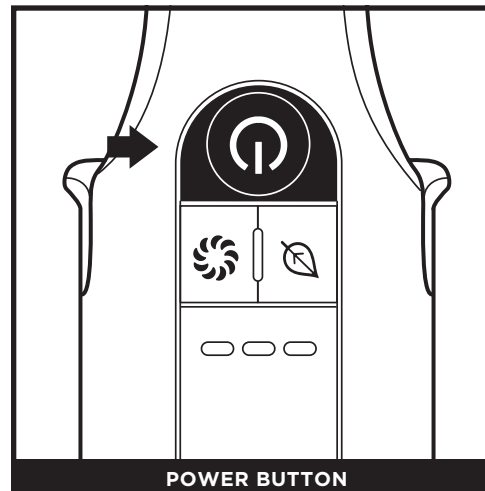
RECYCLING THE LITHIUM-ION BATTERY

When replacing the lithium-ion battery, dispose of or recycle it in accordance with the local collection rules where you live. Depending on the region where you live, lithium-ion batteries are collected in different ways. Either take the battery you wish to dispose of to a center that collects items for recycling or to the store where you bought the product, or recycle it after contacting the municipality where you live.

NOTE: Like normal lithium-ion batteries, the maximum charge capacity of the Shark rechargeable battery will lessen over the years relative to a new product with 100% capacity.

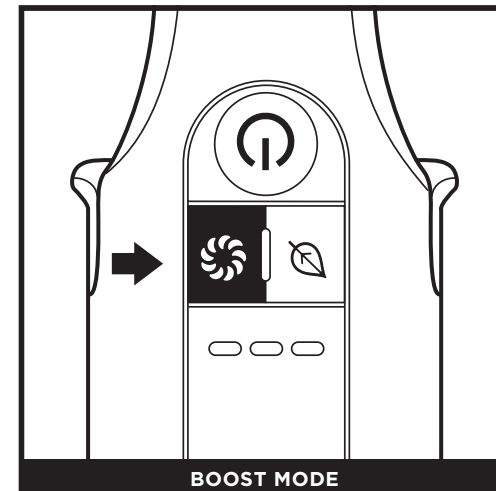
HOW TO USE

BUTTON FUNCTIONS



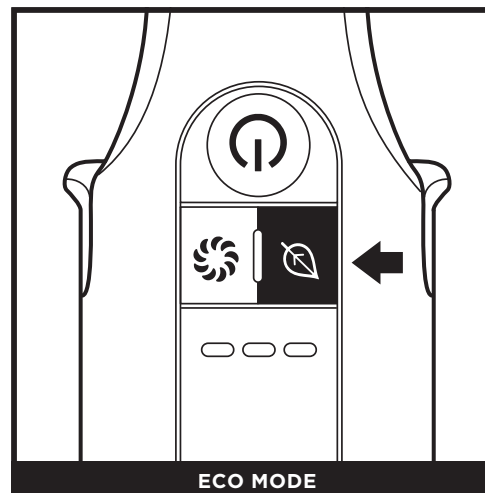
POWER BUTTON

To turn on the power of the vacuum cleaner, press the power button on the handle. To turn the power off, press the button again. (Normal Mode)



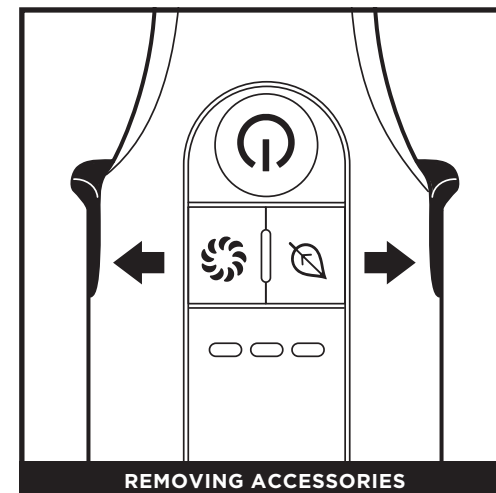
BOOST MODE

To change to Boost Mode, which provides more powerful suction, press the Boost button. To return to Normal Mode, press the button again.



ECO MODE

Press the Eco button to switch to change to Eco Mode, in which the device makes less noise when running. To return to Normal Mode, press the button again.

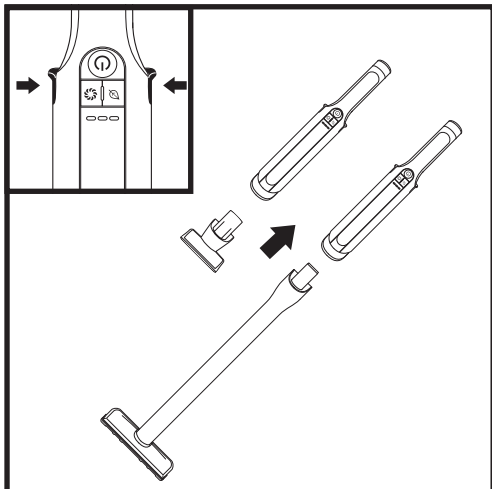


REMOVING ACCESSORIES

To remove accessories that have been installed on the vacuum cleaner, lift the tabs on either side of the handle. After the tabs are lifted, the accessory will be pushed out slightly in front and can be easily removed.

CLEANING WITH ACCESSORIES

INSTALLING AND REMOVING ACCESSORIES



To install accessories on the vacuum cleaner, insert them by sliding them into place on the nozzle opening side.
To remove accessories, lift the grips on either side of the handle.
After the grips are lifted, the accessory will be pushed out slightly in front and can be removed easily.

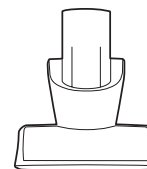

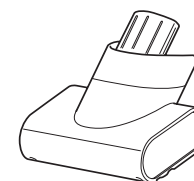
Duster Crevice Tool

A nozzle for crevices with a brush that can be pulled out.
Suitable for cleaning corners of rooms, baseboards, crevices in furniture, car interiors, and other small spaces.



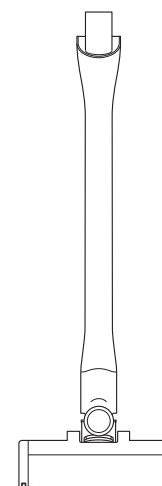
Upholstery Tool

Suitable for cleaning fine dust from fabric furniture surfaces, etc.



Motorized Hand Tool

Suitable for removing allergens, dirt, and hair from various surfaces using a powerful motor.

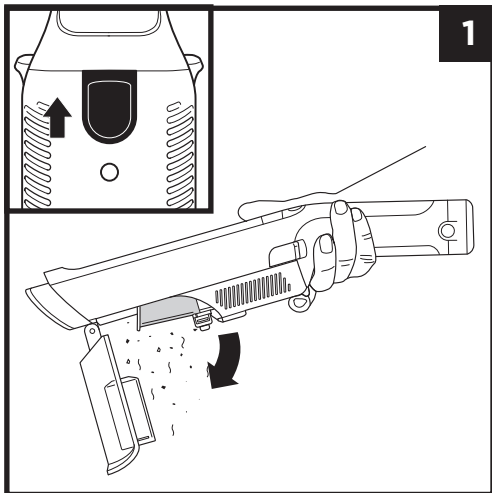


Active Floor Nozzle and Wand

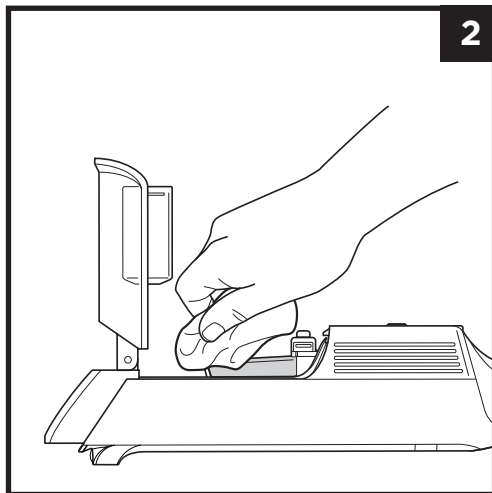
The electric nozzle powerfully removes large debris and dust from the floor, for instance from carpets and rugs. The compact head can easily reach even tight spaces, thoroughly cleaning debris from hard-to-reach areas such as the corners of rooms.

MAINTENANCE

EMPTYING THE DUST CUP

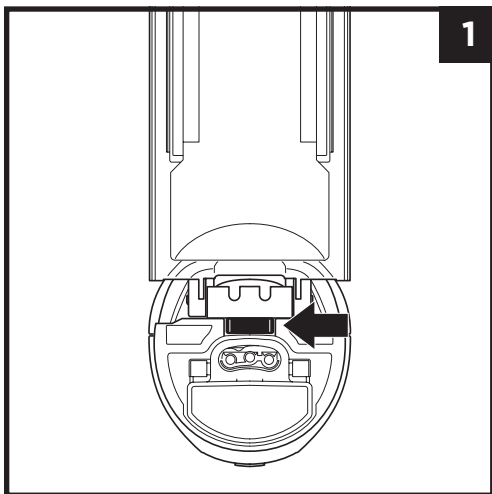


1. With the power off, hold the dust cup over a trash can. Slide the debris disposal button on the bottom forward to open the dust cup.

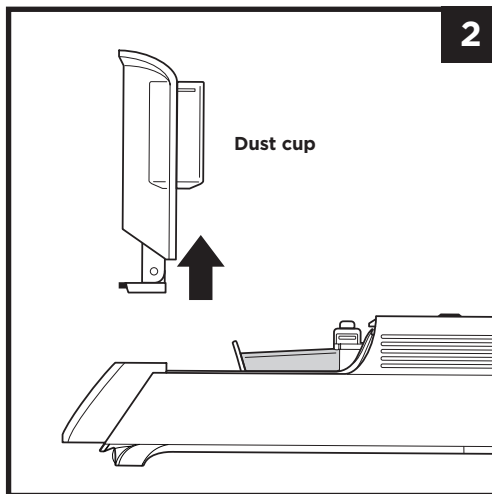


2. As needed, use a dry cloth to remove clumps of debris and clinging dirt.

CLEANING THE DUST CUP



1. With the power off and the dust cup open, press the release button on the bottom of the dust cup.

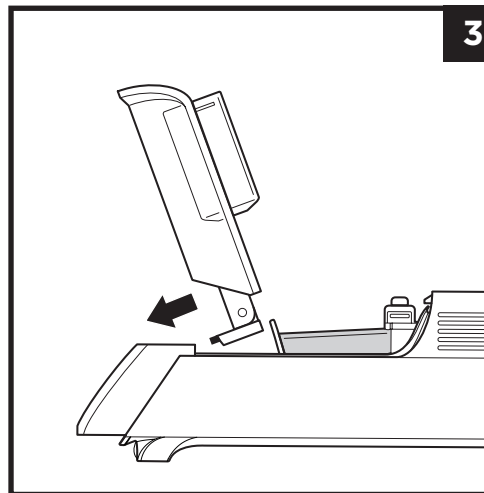


2. While pressing the button, pull out the dust cup. Wash the dust cup by hand with water and detergent and let it dry. When reattaching it, make sure it is completely dry.

NOTE: Do not wash parts and accessories in a dishwasher.

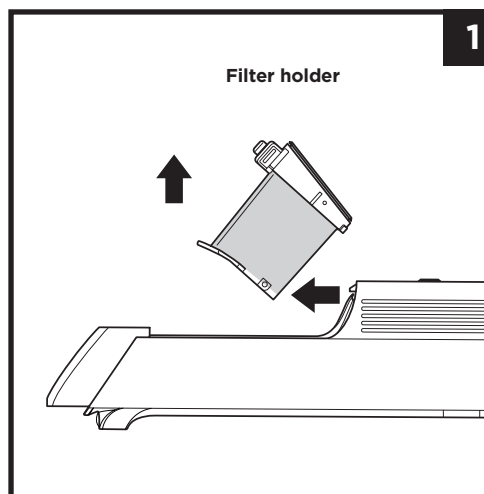
CLEANING THE DUST CUP (CONTINUED)



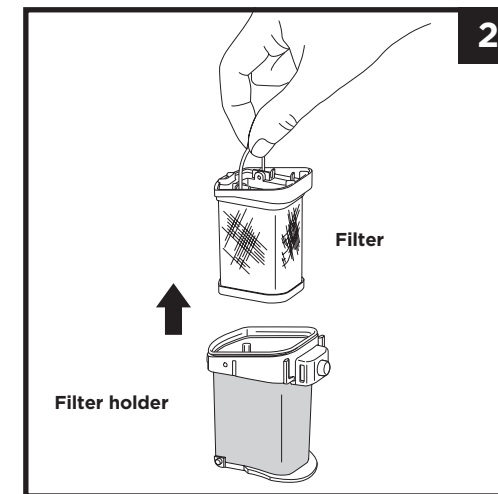
3. To reattach, insert the dust cup into the slot on the bottom of the nozzle by sliding it and push until you hear a click.

NOTE: Clean the dust cup regularly to maintain suction power and to facilitate ease of use, particularly when using the active floor nozzle and wand.

CLEANING THE FILTER



1. With the power off, holding the vacuum cleaner horizontally, remove the filter holder by lifting it up with the dust cup open.



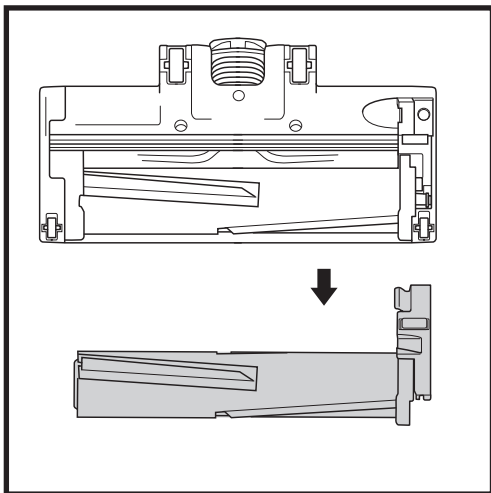
2. Above a trash can, hold the metal ring and pull the filter out of the filter holder. Lightly tap the filter and filter holder to remove debris and dust and then rinse the filter and filter holder with water. When reinstalling the filter and filter holder, make sure that the filter is completely dry before installing it in the vacuum cleaner. Drying time will vary depending on the season and environment. If the filter is used when not fully dry, it may become moldy or cause the vacuum to malfunction.

MAINTENANCE

CLEANING THE NOZZLE HEAD AND BRUSH ROLL (INCLUDED WITH WV517TW)

If debris and foreign objects get caught in the brush roll and are not removed as you continue cleaning, remove this material before continue to use the vacuum cleaner.

If you have vacuumed up hard items or sharp debris, or if the device makes unusual noises, remove all debris and clinging dust from the nozzle suction port and brush roll.



1. Turn off the power to the vacuum cleaner, remove the nozzle from the vacuum cleaner, pull the tab on the back of the nozzle, and remove the brush roll.
2. Remove dust by tapping lightly and wipe the brush roll with a clean, dry cloth. Remove any debris that may be lodged in the skewer-shaped parts inside the nozzle.
3. If the brush roll is extremely dirty, use only water to wash the brush roll by hand and let it dry for at least 24 hours.
4. Once the brush roll is completely dry, replace it in the nozzle and make sure that it is seated firmly in place with a click.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

⚠ Warning: To reduce the risk of electric shock and malfunction of the vacuum cleaner, be sure to turn the power off and remove the battery before proceeding.

Power to the vacuum cleaner turns off.

There are several possible reasons if the power to the vacuum cleaner turns off by itself including obstruction of the suction pathway, an issue with the battery, overheating, and so on. In this case, try the following steps.

1. Turn on the power to the vacuum cleaner and check the indicator lights. If the battery needs to be charged, before charging it in the charging dock, ensure that the power button on the vacuum cleaner is turned off.
2. Empty debris in the dust cup and clean the filter (for details, see “Emptying the dust cup” and “Cleaning the dust cup” on page 12 and “Cleaning the filter” on page 13).
3. Check to see if the vacuum cleaner or the suction port of an accessory is obstructed by a foreign object. Remove any objects you may find.
4. If the vacuum cleaner or the battery has overheated, let it stand for at least 45 minutes until it has cooled to room temperature.
5. Press the power button to run the vacuum cleaner.

The vacuum cleaner does not suck up debris. Suction is weak.

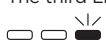
- The dust cup is full: Remove the debris and empty the dust cup.
- Check whether debris is caught in the nozzle: Remove any stuck debris as needed.
- Check whether the suction pathway of the vacuum cleaner or an accessory is obstructed by a foreign object: Remove any stuck foreign objects as needed.
- Check to see if the filter is dirty. For instructions on installing the filter and drying it after removing and washing it, see “Cleaning the filter” on page 13.

A liquid has been vacuumed up by mistake.

- This could cause an electric shock, short circuit, fire, etc. Promptly turn off the power to the vacuum cleaner and remove the battery from the vacuum cleaner.
- Use a soft cloth or towel to wipe down all areas of the vacuum cleaner suction port that may have gotten wet and let dry for at least 24 hours until fully dry.
- Remove the dust cup, filter holder, and filter from the vacuum cleaner, clean with water, wipe off any moisture with a towel or soft cloth, and let dry for at least 24 hours until fully dry.
- Check that all the parts are fully dry, install the parts and battery, and test the operation of the vacuum cleaner. If something unexpected occurs, for instance if there is a strange odor or the vacuum cleaner fails to operate, turn off the power immediately, remove the battery, and contact customer support.

TROUBLESHOOTING (CONTINUED)

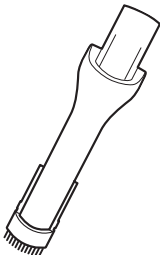
Reasons why the indicator lights of the vacuum cleaner are flashing and solutions

Indicator light status	Reason	Solution
The three indicator lights are all flashing white 	The battery is not seated firmly in the vacuum cleaner	If possible, try using another battery. Insert the battery into the vacuum cleaner by sliding it until you hear a click. If the issue is still not solved, contact customer support.
The first and third LEDs are blinking 	The vacuum cleaner may have overheated	Let the vacuum cleaner and battery cool for approximately 45 minutes until they reach room temperature.
The first and second LEDs are blinking 	Excess current or short circuit	Turn off the power, remove any stuck debris, and turn the power back on.
The first LED is blinking 	Remaining battery charge is low	Charge the battery by placing the vacuum cleaner on the charging dock.
The second LED is blinking 	The motor may be overloaded	Turn off the power and check whether debris is caught in the suction port, etc. If there is any debris stuck within, remove it and turn the power back on. If the problem is still not resolved, contact customer support.
The third LED is blinking 	Conduction failure	Contact customer support.
The second and third LEDs are blinking 	It is possible that the charging dock may be malfunctioning	Use the included genuine Shark charging dock. If the issue is still not resolved, contact customer support.
The first and third LEDs are blinking alternately with the second 	The filter may not be seated properly	With the dust cup open, remove the filter holder by lifting it out and pull the filter from the filter holder, holding it by the metal ring. Firmly reseal the filter in the filter holder, return the filter holder to its original position, and close the dust cup. If the issue is still not resolved, contact customer support.

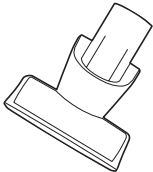

The One (1) Year Limited Warranty applies to purchases made from authorized retailers of **OSONOVA PRIVATE LIMITED TAIWAN BRANCH**. Warranty coverage applies to the original owner and to the original product only and is not transferable.

SharkNinja warrants that the unit shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of purchase when it is used under normal household conditions and maintained according to the requirements outlined in the Owner's Guide, subject to the following conditions and exclusions:

What is covered by this warranty?

1. The original unit and/or non-wearable components deemed defective, in SharkNinja's sole discretion, will be repaired or replaced up to one (1) year from the original purchase date.
2. In the event a replacement unit is issued, the warranty coverage ends six (6) months following the receipt date of the replacement unit or the remainder of the existing warranty, whichever is later. SharkNinja reserves the right to replace the unit with one of equal or greater value.

What is not covered by this warranty?

1. Normal wear and tear of wearable parts (such as foam filters, HEPA filters, pads, etc.), which require regular maintenance and/or replacement to ensure the proper functioning of your unit, are not covered by this warranty. Replacement parts are available for purchase at **sharkninja.tw**.
2. Any unit that has been tampered with or used for commercial purposes.
3. Damage caused by misuse (e.g., vacuuming up water or other liquids), abuse, negligent handling, failure to perform required maintenance (e.g., not cleaning the filters or not removing debris from the brushroll), or damage due to mishandling in transit.
4. Consequential and incidental damages.
5. Defects caused by repair persons not authorized by SharkNinja. These defects include damages caused in the process of shipping, altering, or repairing the SharkNinja product (or any of its parts) when the repair is performed by a repair person not authorized by SharkNinja.
